If it should come to the attention of the Oakdale Electric Cooperative that a member's wiring or other equipment is defective and in danger of causing personal harm or danger to members property or to Cooperative equipment, notice shall be made in writing to the member. The notice shall include:

- 1. A description of the member's defective equipment or wiring.
- 2. A statement to the effect that it shall be the responsibility of the owner to repair or to correct the fault or defect so as to be in compliance with requirements of the National, State and / or Local applicable electrical codes.
- 3. Notice to the effect that any expenses to the Cooperative from member's defective or worn out equipment and /or faulty wiring shall be considered the member's responsibility.
- 4. That the Cooperative will be giving notice to a period of no more than 45 days to correct faulty wiring or defective equipment.
- 5. The Cooperative also may disconnect residential utility service without notice, where a dangerous condition exists for as long as the condition exists. PSC 113.0301
