SIGHTS

- **Stone Steps:** Climb the 223 stone step to the top of Mill Bluff at *Mill Bluff State Park*.
- **Rock Walls:** View the 500-million-year-old sandstone gorge at *Rocky Arbor State Park*.
- **ATV/UTV Trails:** Explore the diverse scenery of our service territory with an off-road vehicle from *Mittelstaedt Sports & Marine*.



SOUNDS

- **Birds Calling:** Observe the 110 species of migratory and resident wildlife at *Necedah National Wildlife Refuge*.
- **Fishermen Casting:** Explore the different fishing holes on the Petenwell Flowage at *Wilderness County Park*.
- **Bees Buzzing:** Walk the *Dexter County Park* trail to listen to the sounds of pollinators at work.
- **Club Swinging:** Drive, chip, putt the 18 holes at *Hiawatha Golf Course*.



TASTES

- **Real Maple Syrup:** Stop at *Black Bear Fruits* roadside stand to pick up a jar of real maple syrup.
- **Grilled Meats:** Fire up the charcoal grill with fresh, local meats from *Wisconsin River Meats* or *Meat Smyth, LLC* and dine alfresco.
- **Morel Mushrooms:** Seek out this seasonal delicacy and prepare with specialty seasonings from *Humbird Cheese*.
- **Wine:** Relax on the patio with a glass of wine from *Burr Oak Winery*.
- **Ice Cream:** Roll the windows down at *Lake Dexter Drive-in* to curb a sweet tooth with an ice cream treat.



SMELLS

- **Fresh Flowers:** Add some color to your home or business with flowers from *The Shed, Twin Bluffs Country Market*, or *Cranberry Country Market*.
- **Mowed Grass:** Keep your lawn looking sharp with a mower from *Grangers, LLC*.
- **Camp Fires:** Purchase a custom fire ring or pit from *John's Welding, LLC* to make memories by the fire.
